SCHEDULED ORIENTATIONS:

The cost of the orientation workshop is \$200. Orientations are scheduled from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., both days. You must register and pay for an event through the Georgia Courts Registrar, <https://gcr.onegovcloud.com/>, by 11:59 PM on the deadline. You must register and pay for the English written exam separately. Registrations and payments received after the deadline will not be processed. No exceptions will be made. First priority will be given to those seeking certification for languages other than Spanish and those who reside in high-need areas of Georgia. **Out-of-state residents are only accepted if seating is still available after placement of Georgia residents.**

SCHEDULED ENGLISH WRITTEN EXAMS:

The cost of the written exam is \$50. The English written exams are conducted the day after the two weeks after the two-day orientation workshop, on a Friday. The cost of the written exam **is not** included in the cost of the orientation. You must apply and pay for the written exam separately. You are not required to take the exam immediately following the orientation; you can register for any scheduled exam session. Registrations & payments must be received in our office by 11:59 PM on the deadline. Registration and payment deadlines for the written exam are the same as those for the scheduled orientations.

SCHEDULED ORAL CERTIFICATION EXAMS:

The cost of the oral certification exam is \$250. Exam registration and payment must be received through the Georgia Courts Registrar by 11:59 PM on the deadline. **Registrations and payments received after the deadline will not be processed.** No exceptions will be made. First priority will be given to those seeking certification for languages other than Spanish and those who reside in high-need areas of Georgia. **Out-of-state residents are only accepted if seating is still available after placement of Georgia residents.**

If you do not complete the licensing process within two years of your scheduled orientation, you must retake and pass the English written exam to remain active in our system. Applicants may request an extension of time by completing an approved skill-builder and submitting a request to the staff of the Commission on Interpreters.
