## Sample Courthouse COVID-19 Screening Protocol

**Instructions:** Courthouse security or designated employees: Upon entering the courthouse, all visitors must attest to or acknowledge to no known illness by responding to the following statements. It is also recommended that persons conducting the screenings should wear a mask and sterile gloves while practicing social distancing with no less than a three (3) foot barrier.

### COVID-19 Sample Screening Statements



- I attest that I have not traveled to a high-risk area or location identified as a "hot spot" of confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) cases within the last 14 days.
- To the best of my knowledge, I have not had contact with a person confirmed or presumed to have coronavirus (COVID-19) within the last 14 days.
- I attest that I have not exhibited a fever of 100° F degrees or higher within the last 14 days.
- I attest that I have not experienced any difficulty breathing or persistent cough within the last 14 days.
- To the best of my knowledge, I am not currently experiencing any upper respiratory illnesses accompanied by a fever.
