SWAINSBORO MUNICIPAL COURT COVID-19 GUIDELINES

The Supreme Court of the State of Georgia has issued an Order mandating Operations Guidelines to be implemented during the Covid-19 pandemic. This court will follow such guidelines to ensure the safety of all parties involved. The following guidelines will be implemented during all court procedures.

- Everyone will be required to wear a mask when entering the building. If you
 do not have a mask, one will be provided to you.
- Temperatures will be taken. If you have a temperature of 100 or better, you will be asked to leave the building. Your court case will be rescheduled for the next court date.
- Anyone who has tested positive for Covid-19, or is experiencing symptoms
 within 14 days of their court date should contact the Swainsboro Municipal
 Court and ask for a continuance. If case has already been continued prior at
 their request, documentation supporting their illness will be required.
- 4. Everyone will practice social distancing, which is six (6) feet apart when entering the building and courtroom. There will be a sign in sheet with the receptionist. There is limited seating in the lobby area and the courtroom. Names will be called by the order that they are signed in.
- 5. All attorney cases will be heard first.
- 6. Sanitizer will be provided when signing in and in the courtroom.
- 7. The podium will be disinfected after each case.
- 8. Sanitizer will be provided for judge, attorneys, probation, and any other attendees for court.
- No children will be allowed in the building. Make arrangements for childcare if appearing in court.
- 10. Anyone under the age of 21, only one parent is allowed in the courtroom.
