GUIDELINES FOR JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

In order to provide a safe environment for all Courthouse personnel, visitors, litigants, defendants, and attorneys, the following procedures are in effect:

- All persons entering the Courthouse must wear a mask and shall be screened for cough, fever, and recent exposure to Covid-19. Persons with a temperature of 100.2 or above will not be admitted.
- If you are scheduled for Court and are being quarantined or under a physician's care for Covid-19, call the office at 912-437-4888 to be rescheduled.
- All persons shall remain at least 6 feet apart while in the building, office, and courtroom. This does not apply to people living together or those who arrive in the same vehicle.
- No more than 1 person or 1 couple at a time shall be admitted to go the clerk's window. Appointments are requested for all business except for court cases which have been scheduled. Those arriving at the courthouse without an appointment will be given the office phone number to call for admittance to the office.
- Our courtroom is small and seating is limited to the litigants and their attorneys. Witnesses are generally sequestered. If there are to be visitors in attendance or more than 6 people in the courtroom, please call in advance so that another courtroom can be used.
- Video hearings for Probate and Magistrate cases will be done upon the consent of all parties. You will use either Zoom or Webex for the video hearing.
- All persons on the premises shall comply with the directives of court security.
