Whereas, it has been determined that a Judicial Emergency exists in Chattooga County in the State of Georgia as there is a serious health emergency pursuant to O.C.G.A. §38-3-60(2)(D).

Whereas, numerous individuals who are employed at work at the Chattooga County Courthouse, Annex Courthouse, and Sheriff's Department have experienced symptoms of Covid-19 and tested positive for the virus.

The Main Courthouse and Annex Courthouse of Chattooga County, Georgia, shall be closed from 9:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 28, 2020, until Monday, August 3, 2020 for cleaning and sanitizing. This will impact the business of the Superior Court, the State Court, the Probate Court, the Magistrate Court, the Clerk of the Court, the Office of the District Attorney, the Office of the Public Defender, and the Community Supervision Offices. All offices will continue to conduct business that is essential and that can be done telephonically or virtually.

This Order shall be amended as necessary.
