It is further ORDERED, that any and all provisions of the Fourth Order Extending Statewide Judicial Emergency issued by the Chief Justice of the Georgia Supreme Court not otherwise addressed in the Court's most recent Standing Order are hereby adopted and made the ORDER of the Superior Courts of this Circuit. Specifically, it is ORDERED that with regard to everyone who works in a court facility, any person with known or suspected COVID-19 infection is required to isolate and the quarantine of any person with COVID-19 exposure likely to result in infection is required, in accordance with the DPH Seventh Amended Administrative Order for Public Health Control Measures, or any subsequent version thereof;


