



ORDER

MAGISTRATE COURT COVID-19 REOPENING PROCEDURES

- All persons entering the courthouse shall be screened for cough, fever, and recent exposure to Covid-19. Persons with a temperature of 100.2 or greater will not be admitted.
- All persons admitted shall wear a face mask or covering that covers the nose and mouth. **BRING YOUR OWN.**
- All persons shall remain at least 6 feet apart on the premises, include the exterior, interior, and parking lot (this does not apply to people living together, or people who arrive in the same vehicle).
- Seating in the courtrooms shall be limited to 9 people, excluding parties and attorneys seated at the litigants' tables for the case before the court.
- Appropriate seating locations on the pews in the courtrooms will be marked. No one shall sit in an unmarked space.
- No more than 2 people at a time shall be admitted to go to the clerks' windows. They shall be spaced no closer than every other window.
- All persons gaining admission shall leave immediately upon concluding their business. No one shall be allowed to loiter in the common areas.
- All persons on the premises shall comply with the directives of court security personnel.
