Emergency Guidelines for in in Court proceedings

ORDER ESTABLISHING GUIDELINES FOR IN COURT PROCEEDINGS

Pursuant to the DECLARATION OF STATEWIDE JUDICIAL EMERGENCY And EXTENSIONS, in compliance with public health guidance provided by the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Georgia Department of Health (DPH) and local health departments, the Municipal Court of Alma, Georgia hereby establishes the following guidelines for persons entering the Municipal Court located at the Bacon County Court House:

- Only Defendants on the court docket are permitted to be in the courtroom. (no family or friends)
- Upon entry to the Court House, staff will take temperature readings of each Defendant before being allowed upstairs to the courtroom. If a fever is indicated, individuals will be refused admittance and directed to leave immediately. Your court date will be rescheduled.
- Individual face masks are required for entry and must always be worn properly (over both nose and mouth). If Defendants do not have a mask, one will be provided for them.
- Hand sanitizer is available at the entrance of the courtroom.
- Courtroom seating for Defendants is limited according to the size of the courtroom to comply with the 6 - foot social distancing guideline as set forth by the CDC. If you must wait in the designated waiting area, you must follow strict social distancing guidelines.
- The courtroom is sanitized after each Municipal Court session.
