IN RE: REIMPOSITION OF DEADLINES FOR UNIFORM SUPERIOR COURT RULE 39.3.1. SEMI-ANNUAL LISTS OF FELONY CASES PENDING POST-TRIAL

Rule 39.3.1 of the Uniform Superior Court Rules requires the chief judge of the superior court for each judicial circuit to electronically submit to the clerk of the Supreme Court no later than February 10 and August 10 of each year a list of all felony cases in the judge's circuit that are either pending judgment on a motion for new trial or transmission of a record on appeal. The August 10, 2020 deadline has been tolled by the Chief Justice's March 14, 2020 Order Declaring Statewide Judicial Emergency, as extended. By this order, the deadline for submitting Rule 39.3.1 reports that would have been due by August 10, 2020 is reimposed so that the report is now due by October 10, 2020, and future Rule 39.3.1 reports will be due by the date set forth in the rule. A copy of this order will be provided to the Council of Superior Court Judges for distribution to all superior court judges.
