

ORDER REOPENING MAGISTRATE COURT OF WARE COUNTY, GEORGIA

On August 13, 2020, this Court executed an Order closing the Ware County Magistrate Court due to various personnel being ill or positive with COVID-19. As of this date, Magistrate Judge Nathan Grantham reports that he and his staff are ready to return to work and have determined that it is safe to do so. Ware County has treated the office again during the interim closure.

Therefore, effective August 28, 2020 at 8:00 a.m., the Magistrate Court of Ware County is reopened. All suspended, tolled, or extended deadlines are reimposed effective upon reopening.
