AMENDED ORDER DECLARING JUDICIAL EMERGENCY

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the **ORDER DECLARING JUDICIAL EMERGENCY** entered by this Court on December 14, 2020, is hereby amended, as follows:


Despite the implementation of adherence to designated safety guidelines necessitated in response to COVID-19, a courthouse employee has tested positive. Therefore, the undersigned has determined that it is no longer feasible to allow the courthouse to remain open to the general public. Effective immediately and until midnight on January 3, 2021, unless further extended by order of this Court, the McIntosh County Courthouse will be closed to the public.

While the courthouse building is closed to the public, essential functions will be provided electronically through online services, by telephone, and by other means or location as may later be provided and noticed to the public.

All other provisions of the previous order will remain in effect. The Court will continue to address essential functions as previously noted. If you have a judicial emergency, please contact the Chief Deputy Clerk of Court at (912) 258-3493.

Service of notice of this **AMENDED ORDER DECLARING JUDICIAL EMERGENCY** shall be made upon all affected parties in the same manner as the original order and a copy of this notice shall be placed upon all entry points to the McIntosh County Courthouse.
