**JUDICIAL ORDER MANDATING MASKS IN COURTROOMS**

**AND POSSIBLE PRE-SCREENING FOR COVID-19 SYMPTOMS**

In accordance with part of the current CDC guidelines and directives of the Georgia Supreme Court;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that all persons entering the Grovetown Municipal Court Annex may be subjected to pre-screening for COVID-19 Symptoms, including the testing of body temperature, prior to entering the Grovetown Municipal Annex so as to prevent the spread and/or infection of others;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that all persons entering the Grovetown Municipal Court Annex shall wear a mask or face-covering when entering the building and/or courtroom;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that employees shall follow the directives of his or her supervisor while working inside of the Grovetown Municipal Court Annex. However, when entering the courtroom, all employees of the Grovetown Municipal Court Annex must wear a mask or face-covering.
