TERMINATION OF LOCAL ORDERS REGARDING COVID PRECAUTION PROCEDURES

MASKS

Whereas the number of new cases of COVID are decreasing from it's record high count. The Court does hereby TERMINATE the previous mask mandate order dated January 12, 2022 and the order dated January 20, 2022 that extended the mask mandate till February 28, 2022.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Social Distancing is NO LONGER required in the Courtrooms or other areas within the Courthouse.

HOWEVER

COMMON SENSE – PRACTICAL PRECAUTIONS

Everyone is reminded to use common sense, and to apply practical precautions. In keeping with the recommendations and guidelines of the CDC.

Persons experiencing a fever, sore throat, shortness of breath, nausea and/or other similar symptoms should NOT come into the Courthouse. If your presence has been requested/demanded by a Court and you are experiencing these symptoms please contact your Attorney or the Court that has requested/demanded your presence by phone prior to reporting.

Also, while no longer required GOOD personal hygiene, hand washing, use of hand sanitizer etc. is still a good practice to have.

Posted orders requiring masks/face coverings, social distancing and similar COVID related precaution procedures are ordered removed from public posting throughout the Courthouse.

This new order shall be posted for public viewing for a period of 30 days from the date of this order.
